SUBJECT: Call to Host Provincial Eight Ball 2012

Memo #77.11

Please bring the information contained in this memo to the attention of the Branch Executive, Branch Sports Chair and the membership for a possible hosting opportunity by the Branch.

General Guidelines: Number of days required to run the event will depend on number of Zones entering, a minimum of 9 (nine) Zones is required. Guidelines for hosting a sporting event are available from Command but please note the timeline will be compacted with this inaugural event.

Timeframe: Play downs must be completed prior to April 15 2012

Rules: As outlined in Sports Guide (Chapter 7)

Table Size: Surface must be approximately 8 or 7 feet
For 8 foot table the playing surface measures 92"x46" (233.68cm x 116.84cm).
For 7 foot table, playing surface measures 76" x 38" (193.04cm x 96.52cm).

Number of Tables: Host Branch must have access to a minimum of 2 (two) tables for tournament play.

Tournament Format: A team, (4 players) doubles, and singles championship format
4 person per Branch format that ends in a reverse pyramid that sees a team, doubles, or single champion crowned using the standings achieved in previous qualification.
Branch teams will enter with identified 2 person teams.

Format Rules: Round Robin play, ties in overall scoring will revert to most wins against each other of the tied teams to determine overall winner.

4 Person Team Championship

2 conferences - 4 divisions

Conference A - provincial team 1 in divisions 1 & 2

Conference B - provincial team 2 in divisions 3 & 4

Round-robin play = 9 games in each division

Total wins from all divisions determines 4 person team winner.

Tie Breaker 1: Ties in overall scoring will revert to most wins against each other of the teams that are tied to determine overall winner.

Tie Breaker 2: Top player from each team in 1 game takes all

2 Person Team Championship

Combined totals from divisions 1 & 2 = team finalist

Combined totals from divisions 3 & 4 = team finalist

In the event of a tie at this level:

Qualification tie breaker 1: Ties in overall scoring will revert to most wins against each other of the teams that are tied to determine overall winner in each.

Qualification tie breaker 2: Top player from each team in 1 game is conference finalist (round-robin if required).

Finals: Round-robin between conference finalist results in 2 person team winner.

Tie breaker: Top player from each team in 1 game determines winner.

Singles Championship

Total wins from each division = top player

Qualification tie breaker 1 (ties within the division): Ties in overall scoring will revert to most wins against each other of the individuals that are tied to determine overall winner.

Qualification tie breaker 2: Round-robin or single game playoff to determine division winners.

Finals qualifier: 4 division top scorers play round-robin. In case of 3 way tie there will be a coin toss to determine who gets the by. Remaining 2 players play 1 game to determine who gets into the finals.

Finals: Top 2 play in best of 3.
